Subject: Drawing:-

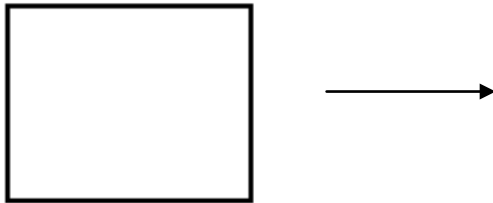
